

UNBOX

- -PACKAGE SHOULD CONTAIN PRINTER, A POWER CORD, AND ANY OPTIONAL ITEMS YOU MAY HAVE PURCHASED
- -STICKER ON BACK OF GUIDE WILL INDICATE MODEL TYPE
- -PLEASE RETAIN ORIGINAL PACKAGING IN CASE OF A REPAIR




USB

- -CONNECT POWER CABLE TO BACK OF PRINTER AND OUTLET
- -CONNECT COMMUNICATION CABLE TO PRINTER PORT AND COMPUTER + POWER ON THE PRINTER
- -SEE SECTIONS 2B, 2C, +2D for WiFi, Bluetooth, + Ethernet setup










WINDOWS

FOR WINDOWS USE:


- -GO TO "microcomcorp.com/products/485t"
- -SCROLL DOWN PRODUCT PAGE AND CLICK "DOWNLOAD WINDOWS DRIVER" BUTTON
- -READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIALOGUE BOX INSTRUCTIONS



FGL

FOR FGL USE:

-AFTER COMPLETING STEPS 1 + 2, NO FURTHER ACTION IS REQUIRED TO CONNECT



LOAD

- -LOOSEN GREEN THUMBSCREW AND ADJUST GREEN MEDIA GUIDES TO FIT PREFERRED MEDIA
- -AFTER ADJUSTMENT, RETIGHTEN GREEN THUMBSCREW
- -FEED MEDIA INTO MEDIA ENTRY SLOT (ONCE PRINTER DETECTS MEDIA, IT WILL AUTO FEED AND ALIGN PAPER)



TEST

TO PRINT TEST TICKET WITH FGL, PRESS PRINT BUTTON ONCE TO PRINT TEST TICKET WITH WINDOWS DRIVER:

- -GO TO "CONTROL PANEL" THEN "DEVICES AND PRINTERS"
- -RIGHT CLICK THE 485TC AND SELECT PRINTER PROPERTIES
- -CLICK "PRINT TEST PAGE"

2_B BLUETOOTH

INSTALL BLUETOOTH DONGLE IN HOST USB PORT **BLUETOOTH SETUP:**

-From the home screen, select CONFIG MENU and then OPTIONAL PORTS. Make sure Bluetooth is selected and tap Save. Reboot the printer if prompted.

AFTER DOWNLOADING WINDOWS DRIVER (SEE 3A):

- -Pair your printer to the PC via Bluetooth.
- -Go to "Control Panel" then "Devices and Printers".
- -Right-click your Bluetooth printer listing (Microcom485-BT by default) and select Properties.
- -In the Hardware tab, make a note of the COM number next to Standard Serial over Bluetooth Link.
- -Back in the Devices and Printers menu, right-click your Microcom Printer Driver listing and select Printer Properties.
- -In the Ports tab, make sure the assigned COM port matches what was listed earlier in the Standard Serial over Bluetooth Link listing.

2c ETHERNET

PLUG IN ETHERNET CABLE

CONFIGURE NETWORK SETTINGS:

- -From the home screen, select CONFIG MENU and then OPTIONAL PORTS. Make sure Ethernet is selected and tap Save. Reboot the printer if prompted.
- -You can configure network parameters by selecting CONFIG MENU and then ETHERNET.

AFTER DOWNLOADING WINDOWS DRIVER (SEE 3A):

- -Go to "Control Panel" then "Devices and Printers".
- -Right-click your Microcom Printer Driver listing and select Printer Properties.
- -In the Ports tab, select Add Port. Highlight Standard TCP/IP Port and click New Port.
- -Follow the prompts to set up a network port using your printer's IP address and port number (you can check the IP/port in the PRINTER INFO menu).
- -Back in the Ports menu of the Printing Preferences, select the new network port and click Apply.

DIAGNOSTICS

TO VIEW PRINTER'S HARDWARE, USAGE, AND NETWORK INFO:

- -Tap CONFIG MENU from the homescreen.
- -Click NEXT to scroll through items until you reach PRINTER INFO.
- -This process is the same for both FGL + IMAGE mode.

2_D WIFI

INSTALL Wi-Fi DONGLE IN HOST USB PORT

CONFIGURE NETWORK SETTINGS:

- -From the home screen, select CONFIG MENU and then OPTIONAL PORTS. Make sure Wi-Fi is selected and tap Save. Reboot the printer if prompted.
- -You can configure network parameters by selecting CONFIG MENU and then Wi-Fi.

AFTER DOWNLOADING WINDOWS DRIVER (SEE 3A):

- -Go to "Control Panel" then "Devices and Printers"
- -Right-click your Microcom Printer Driver listing and select Printer Properties.
- -In the Ports tab, select Add Port. Highlight Standard TCP/IP Port and click New Port.
- -Follow the prompts to set up a network port using your printer's IP address and port number (you can check the IP/port in the PRINTER INFO menu).
- -Back in the Ports menu of the Printing Preferences, select the new network port and click Apply.
